#### No. of Surrey Catalytic Converter Thefts (per day)









A small number of Organised Crime Groups are travelling into Surrey to steal catalytic converters. They do this with great ease and often steal multiple in one go. They mostly target older hybrid cars, in car parks, in the middle of the day.



# Why was it happening so often? Offender PROTECT Protect your car by asking your dealer if they can give you any advice on locks or guards that are approved by the vehicle manufacturer and tested to Sold Secure Gold.

Mark your catalytic converter with a forensic marker and register your converter to make it harder for thieves to dispose of.

Park your car somewhere well-lit and overlooked, amongst as many cars as possible. Try to park so the converter can't be easily reached - close to a wall or fence. Try not to park at the end of the row if there are free spaces.



**Pre-response** 


**During response rollout** 

**%** of calls via 999







### Long-term results

#### Surrey catalytic converter thefts & calls via 999 (up to May 2023)



### Was it cost effective? £485,865 saved in 6 months

#### £1.71m in 26 months
