- Research/Advisory Team not just to evaluate!




### Scanning: Defining the Problem

Disparate data systems





Few contacts officer self-initiated









#### Safety Concerns at Encampments

#### SURVEYED POLICE EMPLOYEES OFTEN/ALWAYS SEE...


Excessive trash or human caused debris
Individuals exhibiting non-normative behaviors
Bicycle parts (e.g., tires, spare parts)
Shopping Carts
Hypodermic Needle(s)
Knife, box knife, sword, or other cutting weapon/tool
Other Hazardous Waste (e.g., paint, oil, batteries)
Human Fecal Waste
Individuals actively engaged in drug use
Propane Tanks
Active fires or conditions conducive to fires
Firearm or item that looks like a firearm











